

EXIM Thailand Welcomes Pakistan's Water and Power Development Authority

The Bank provided financial support to numerous domestic and overseas power plant projects with an aggregate capacity of 7,490 MW, representing EXIM Thailand's total exposure of 1,138 million US dollars, 59% of which goes to hydropower projects.

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
